The Service & Support Administration (SSA) Transition Services team partners with families, local educational entities, and other service providers to offer guidance and be a resource. A Transition SSA is available to serve students aged 14-22 years who have been found eligible for services through the LCBDD.

The Transition SSA is able to help with the following:

- Attend Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) meetings
- Provide information and referral to community resources
- Assist in the development of a Transition Plan for life after school
- Exploration of and linkage to adult services, as appropriate
- Provide support for families as they begin the county board eligibility process
