Dear Parents, Guardians, & Providers:

Even though we are still enjoying some beautiful fall weather, winter will soon be upon us, so preparing for potential closings is important.

Any weather related or emergency closing will be announced on radio stations 89.7 FM; 90.3 FM; 103.3 FM; and 104.9 FM. and on TV stations WVIZ/PBS Channel 25, WKYC Channel 3, News 5 Cleveland, and Fox 8. The announcement may state "No Morning Transportation" but could keep the Programs open. For those individuals who use Laketrans or other transportation services, please check directly with the transportation provider to see if their transportation services are operating on these "No Morning Transportation" days.

Please remember that the only authorized and accurate source of information about program closings or LCBDD transportation service will be available on a recorded message that can be heard by calling 350-5299 or 918-5299.

In the event of an emergency or inclement conditions that require early dismissal, the parents of those LCBDD transportation riders who require a person to be present at their home will be notified by telephone or Tiger Connect prior to the transportation of their son or daughter. Please be sure the school, adult programs, Transportation Department, and/or Private Transportation Provider have your correct home, work, and emergency telephone numbers for contacting you.
