Major Unusual Incident (MUI) Unit

We are committed to the health and safety of individuals who receive services from the Lake County Board of Developmental Disabilities (LCBDD)/Deepwood. Our MUI Unit is comprised of Investigative Agents (IAs) who complete administrative investigations and reviews in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 5123-17-02 .

The primary goal of an MUI investigation/review is to identify the contributing factors of an incident, enabling the development of preventative measures to help avoid the incident from re-occurring. The MUI Unit is dedicated to ensuring people's safety.
