Parks/Recreation

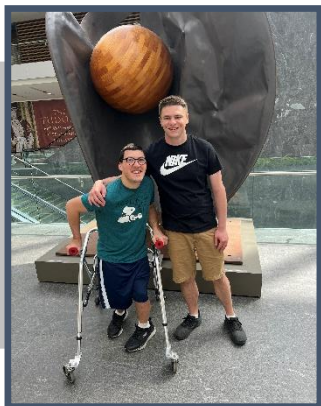
