- Destination planning and map navigation
- Reading bus schedules
- Fare payment, Easy Fare, and reduced fare programs
- Rides On Demand (scheduling, canceling, and managing rides)
- Bus etiquette and safety



The session will include a “Touch-a-Bus” experience and tour, where participants can explore the bus and practice their new transit skills in a supportive, hands-on environment.

Learning how to use public transportation can greatly enhance independence, increase community access, and promote healthier lifestyles by walking or biking to bus stops. This is a meaningful step in helping individuals and their families feel confident navigating transportation safely and independently.
