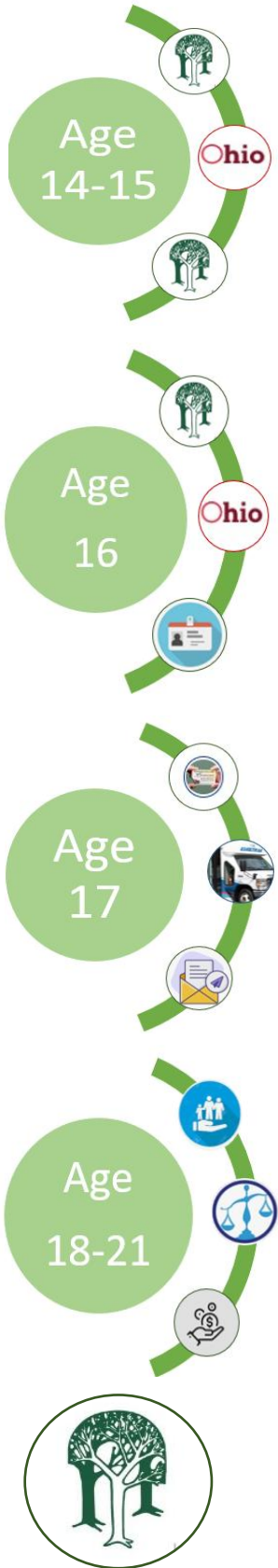


Transition Services Timeline by Age



Age 14 - 15 Years:

Age 16 Years (complete all of the above and the following):

- Schedule an Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument (OEDI) with the LCBDD: www.LakeBDD.org/eligibility/ or call 440-350-5145
- Begin planning for a Summer Youth Work Experience through OOD
- Obtain a Social Security card: www.ssa.gov/ssnumber/ss5doc.htm
- Obtain a State ID: www.bmv.ohio.gov/dl-id-card.aspx
- Set up a bank account in the student's name

Age 17 Years (complete all of the above and the following):

- Obtain a Golden Buckeye Card: www.aging.ohio.gov/about-us/learn-about-golden-buckeye/get-a-golden-buckeye-card-1
- Consider Laketran Travel Training (including Dial-A-Ride): www.laketran.com/riding-laketran/travel-training
- Set up an email address with the student

Age 18 - 21 Years (complete all of the above and the following):

- Apply for Social Security: www.ssa.gov
- Apply for Medicaid: www.medicaid.ohio.gov
- Apply for guardianship if appropriate: www.LakeCountyOhio.gov/probate-court
- Set up a STABLE Account: www.StableAccount.com
