Family Support Services

Family Support Services (FSS) is a locally funded grant program intended for individuals who qualify for services from the Lake County Board of Developmental Disabilities. FSS funds provide financial assistance to families and individuals through full or partial reimbursement of approved expenditures with the reimbursement rate approvals based on a sliding fee scale and up to the approved annual allocation limit.

Once an eligible individual is successfully enrolled in FSS, reimbursements can be provided for many goods and services not otherwise funded by other sources and as related to the individual's qualifying developmental diagnosis.

Specific documentation from a qualified professional may be required to support the individual's request.



The Lake County Board of Developmental Disabilities is devoted to helping individuals and their families live as they choose, while promoting their health, safety, and welfare.
