Transition-Age Services

The Lake County Board of Developmental Disabilities (LCBDD)/Deepwood recognizes that the transition from high school to adulthood can be challenging for persons who have disabilities. In order to better serve your student, we have developed Transition Services.

Transition Services partners with individuals, their families, local educational entities, and other service providers to offer guidance and serve as a resource. A Transition Service and Support Administrator (SSA) is available to serve students ages 14-22 years who have been found eligible for services through the LCBDD.

The Transition SSA may help by attending Individualized Education Plan (IEP) meetings, developing a Transition Plan for life after school, providing information, referring students to community resources, and facilitating linkage to adult services.
